**Daily Dozen Tips
for Working in the Classroom**



1. Arrive on time for your shift and sign in at the office.
2. Wear your name tag. Put your cell phone on vibrate.
3. Familiarize yourself with the classroom, the workroom, the campus.
4. Check the parent area in your classroom for daily instructions.
5. If you're a morning parent, check on snack. If it is forgotten, use back up or make a phone call.
6. Refrain from interrupting the teacher during a lesson. Wait for a break.
7. Model the teacher. If he/she is asking students to come to the carpet, please assist in getting them there.
8. Students come first, copying/prep work later.
9. Yard duty is important! As soon as students are released for snack/lunch go to your zone.
10. Strive for a 4:1 ratio of positive:corrective interactions with students.
11. If you can't attend your shift, find a sub and always contact your classroom coordinator.
12. Never do for children what they can do for themselves.
